Research Ethics/Guidelines for researchers of the institution:

The institution encourages its faculty members and students to engage in research and innovation activities that have positive impact on immediate as well as long term issues of the society. However, while going to undertake any research activities the institution also insists the participants to adhere to general ethical guidelines and research practices. The Research Cell of the institution recommends the following points to be considered carefully while undertaking/reporting any research related activities:

- If necessary, the researchers must take permission from relevant agencies/organizations, specially, in case of experiments involving animals, human subjects, hazardous materials (both chemical and biological origin).
- 2. The researchers/authors should give appropriate reference to earlier works/reports done by others in prescribed format of journals, periodicals, books or any other electronic publishing mediums.
- 3. The authors must acknowledge all the people involved in the experiments, data acquisition, data collection, analysis and report writing. It is also mandatory to acknowledge the funding agency/organization if the research work receives any funding.
- 4. Contributions from collaborators and interinstitutional participations must be acknowledged.
- 5. The privacy of human participants must be preserved until and unless there is proper consent from the individual.
- 6. Faculties and students must avoid manipulation and fabrication of research data in any circumstances.
- 7. The manuscripts, articles or book chapters should contain a proper report from an authentic plagiarism software before publication. Plagiarism check may be done by publication agency or institution involved in reviewing, editing and publication.
- 8. The authors of any article, chapter or report must disclose their affiliation.
