Webinar on 'Political Sociology of COVID-19 Pandemic: Some perspectives'



A webinar was conducted on 'Political Sociology of COVID-19 Pandemic: Some perspectives' by Department of Sociology, Sadiya College, in association with IQAC, Sadiya College on 5.07.2021. Dr. Borun Dey, Assistant Professor, Department of Political Science, Dibrugarh University, was invited as resource person for the same. A total of 110 participants from different HEIs attended the webinar. He spoke about the sociological aspects of Covid-19 pandemic, mainly focusing on how different governments have dealt with issues of health versus wealth. He emphasized on the inequality of availability of medical facilities due to difference in monetary status of the people. He also spoke about how different governments across the world had imposed different restrictions on social life in order to contain the spread of Covid-19 pandemic. The impact of all these factors on sociological and political aspects of people's lives were spoken of in details. E-certificates were issued to all the participants.

Webinar on 'Addressing the issues of elderly in changing society'

A webinar was conducted on 'Addressing the issues of elderly in changing society' by the Department of Sociology, in collaboration with IQAC, Sadiya College on 11.07.2021. Dr. Bikash Deka, Assistant Professor, Department of Sociology, Dibrugarh University was invited as resource person for the same. A total of 150 participants from different colleges of the state attended the webinar. The speaker stressed on the fact that the elderly form a significant fraction of the society. With growing age, they face a lot of problems in performing their daily activities. Increasing age often leads to difficulty in mobility, financial insecurity in certain cases, etc. In today's world of growing technical advancements, the use of technology has become unavoidable. Lack of technological knowledge is yet another problem faced by the elderly. 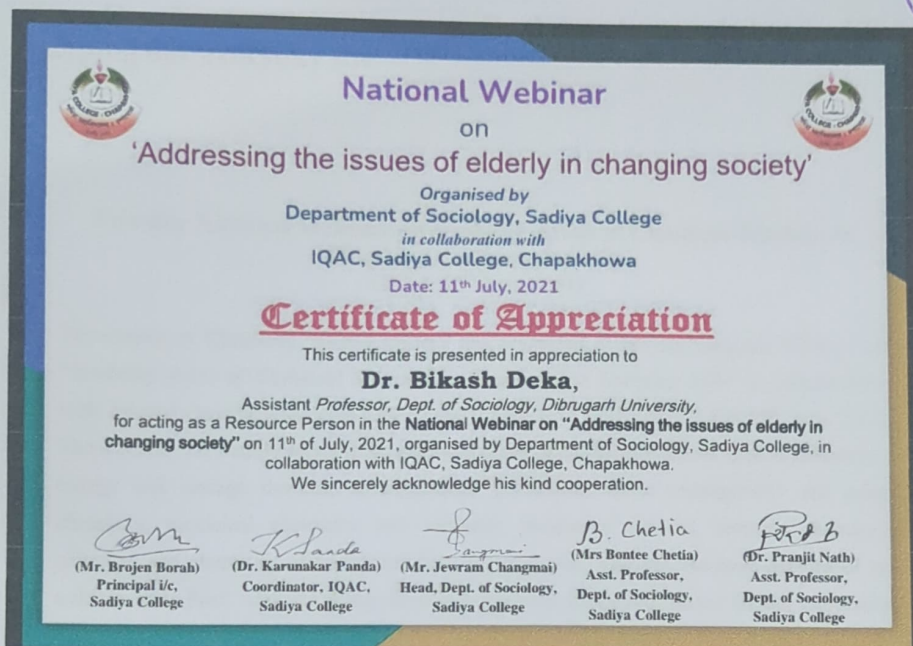

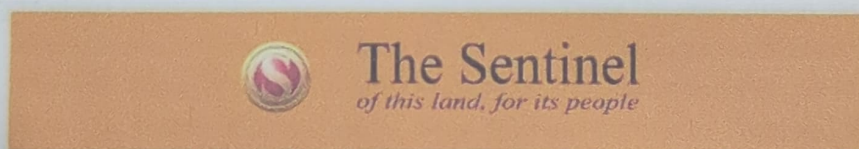

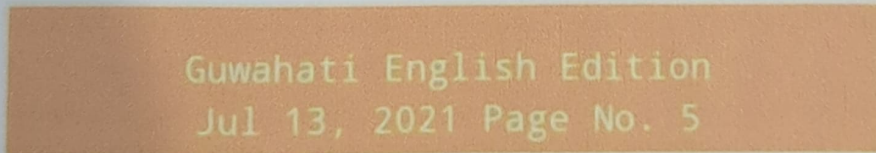
Webinars on issues of elderly, rural development

DOOMDOOMA, July 12: A webinar on 'Addressing the issues of elderly in changing society' was organized by the Department of Sociology, Sadiya College in collaboration with IQAC, Sadiya College on Sunday.
In the webinar, Dr. Bikash Deka, Assistant Professor, Department of Sociology, Dibrugarh University acted as resource person and spoke about various issues of elderly in this changing society. He said that the govern-

ment support in Assam was quite low in comparison to States like Gujarat and Kerala. He expressed his concern on the consequences to be borne by the year 2050 when the proportion of elderly persons who have to be dependent on the younger generation would become more than 20 per cent. He also said that this webinar was first of its kind in Assam and laid great stress on educating the elderly people by organizing such workshops and other means.
The webinar started with

a welcome address by Jewram Changmai, Coordinator and Head, Department of Sociology, followed by speech from Dr. Karunakar Panda, Co-ordinator, IQAC, Sadiya College, who spoke about the importance of PRANAM Commission launched by former Chief Minister of Assam, Sarbananda Sonowal on 26/02/2019. The webinar that was inaugurated by Brojen Borah, Principal (i/c), Sadiya College, was participated by more than 150 participants and came to an end with offering of vote of

thanks by Dr. Jyotsna Keot, Assistant Professor, Department of Botany of the College.
On the other hand, another webinar on 'Issues and Challenges of Sustainable Rural Development: A Brief discussion in the context of Assam' was organized by the Department of Economics in collaboration with IQAC, Sadiya College on Saturday. In the webinar, Dr. Pranjal Pratim Buragohain, Head and Associate Professor, Department of Economics, Dibrugarh University acted as resource person who spoke on various issues and challenges related to sustainable rural development. He said that 75 per cent of the population of Assam was dependent on agriculture and if emphasis was given on provision of incentives, skill upgradation and technical support along with alternative occupation such as pisciculture, piggery, egg production, processed food and meat, then the issues of rural development could be successfully addressed.

Two Day National Webinar on ‘Evolving Areas of chemical Science in shaping our everyday life’

Two-day National Webinar on Evolving Areas of Chemical Sciences in Shaping Our Everyday Life (28th & 29th July, 2021)

Department of Chemistry, Sadiya College has organized a two-day National Webinar on “*Evolving Areas of Chemical Sciences in Shaping Our Everyday Life*” in collaboration with Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), Sadiya College on 28th and 29th July, 2021. The webinar was mainly focused on important areas of chemical sciences such as sustainable energy and storage devices, environmental protection, waste management and green chemistry, medicinal chemistry and wearable diagnostic devices, forensic chemistry, polymers and chemistry of traditional rural technologies. The key resource persons of the webinar were Prof. Alak Kr Buragohain (Chairperson-Academic, Royal Global University, Assam), Prof. Diganta Kr Das (Registrar, Cotton University, Assam), Prof. Pranab Goswami (Professor of Higher Academic Grade, IIT Guwahati, Assam), Dr. Diganta Sarma (Associate Professor, Department of Chemistry, Dibrugarh University, Assam) and Dr. Bipul Sarma (Assistant Professor, Department of Chemical Sciences, Tezpur University, Assam). Three short invited lectures were also delivered by Dr. Kalyani Rajkumari (Assistant Professor of Chemistry, Duliajan College), Dr. Gitashree Darabdhara (Assistant Professor of Chemistry, Suren Das College) and Dr. Rajarshri Bayan (Assistant Professor of Chemistry, Arya Vidyapeeth College).

On first day, Prof. Diganta Kr Das highlighted some of the problems that humanity is currently facing and reminded the responsibilities of chemists to find out sustainable resolution to those problems. Dr. Bipul Sarma discussed about the chemistry involved in drug designing and medicinal values of different plant species commonly found in our surroundings. He also urged the students’ community to make aware of the health and medicinal benefits of those widely available species amongst the peoples in rural areas. A research scholar from Tezpur University also delivered an oral presentation about the research work he has been carrying out. First day agenda was closed with a wonderful lecture by Dr. Kalyani Rajkumari on the topic management of waste to wealth. She cited various examples to ignite the participants upon how the waste can be converted to wealth. The example of Tokyo Olympics 2020 medals which is made up of electronic wastes draws attention of the participants.

The second and final day was started with a keynote lecture by Prof. Alak Kr Buragohain who spoke about the development of chemistry and its contribution to human civilization from a historical perspective to modern era in a chronological manner. He also highlighted the bridge between chemistry and culture as well as the development of recent technologies which are ready to ignite the next industrial revolution. Prof. Pranab Goswami discussed about the chemistry behind biofuel cells and their application in wearable electronic devices and next generation biomedical appliances. Dr. Diganta Sarma gave a lecture on green chemistry and sustainable synthetic approaches using green solvents such as ionic liquids and supercritical carbon dioxide etc. Dr. Gitashree Darabdhara and Dr. Rajarshri Bayan talked about forensic chemistry involving explosive and abusive drugs and application of shape memory polymers, respectively. The two day national webinar was finally closed with vote of thanks by the convener Dr. Rajiv Khatioda, Head, Department of Chemistry, Sadiya College.

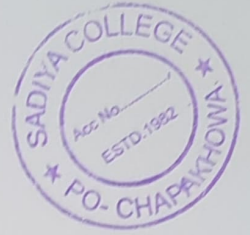

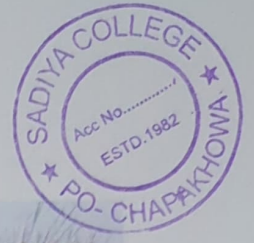
World Wetland Day Celebration
