



ICONIC WEEK CELEBRATION

As a part of the Iconic Week celebration in Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav, a cleanliness and plantation drive was organized by the NSS Unit of Sadiya College at *Shri Shri Boiragi Baba Than*, Sadiya aka Kundil Boiragi Temple, Sadiya, Dist-Tinsukia, Assam on 12th August, 2022.

The Temple is selected as one of the 100 iconic places in India for the year- 2022. The only major Vaishnavite temple in Sadiya is the *Boiragi Than*. It was established by Sri Keshav Dev of Auniati Satra in his exile during the rule of Gadadhar Singha in 17th century. During his exile, he remained as a 'Boiragi': Assamese for a minstrel. It is unique in the sense that in this temple not just Vishnu is worshipped but almost all deities are worshipped, albeit in the form of 'Harinam-Kirtan'.

The iconic week aims to attract the participation of youth and volunteers under the overall spirit of "Jan Bhagidari and Jan Andolan". Keeping in view of the objective, a plantation and cleanliness drive was organized on 12th August, 2022, with more than 25 Volunteers from nearby villages. Due to ongoing Summer Vacations, many volunteers could not come and join the initiative. 


Book fair 2022




Theme of the webinar: Issues & Challenges faced by small business owners.






Talk & Awareness rally on the occasion of World No Tobacco Day
