

#### **ABOUT THE COLLEGE**

Situated in the extreme eastern corner of Assam, Sadiya College is the lone seat of higher learning in the entire sub-division of Sadiya and is accredited with grade B by NAAC in 2024. It is a general degree college provincialized under Assam College Employee Provincialization Act 2005. It is affiliated to Dibrugarh University and recognized by University Grants Commission. The college was established on 6th September, 1982 with the Arts stream and later the Commerce stream was introduced in 2009. The Government of Assam has introduced the Science stream in 2020 to fulfil the need of the entire region for Science Education. The college offers B.A., B.Sc. and B.Com. degree under FYUGP of NEP 2020 and Higher Secondary Courses in Arts, Science and Commerce under ASEB Div II. The college also offers B.A. and M.A. Courses in distance education mode under KKHSOU.

#### **ABOUT SADIYA:**

Sadiya is a small town located in the eastern most part of Tinsukia district, Assam. It is connected to the rest of the country by Dr. Bhupen Hazarika Setu or Dhola -Sadiya bridge, the longest river bridge in India. Sadiya is a historically rich region ruled by the Chutiya Kingdom and later was a province of Ahom Kingdom. The British era Sadiya town was destroyed by the flood of river Brahmaputra during the Earthquake in 1950. The present town was developed after that incident. This region is also known for four Shakti Peeths known as "Chari Shals" worshipped by the tribal priestly clan called the Deoris. While the Tamareswari Devi or the Kechaikhati was famous during the early medieval period, the Burha Burhi's Shal attracts more devotees these days.

The scenic beauty of Sadiya is very impressive as it is situated at the foothills of Himalayas. The beautiful towns of Arunachal Pradesh like Roing, Pasighat, Tezu and Namsai stand close by. The Parashuram Kund situated at Tezu, Arunachal Pradesh is one of the pilgrimage sites which takes about 4 to 5 hours journey by road.
